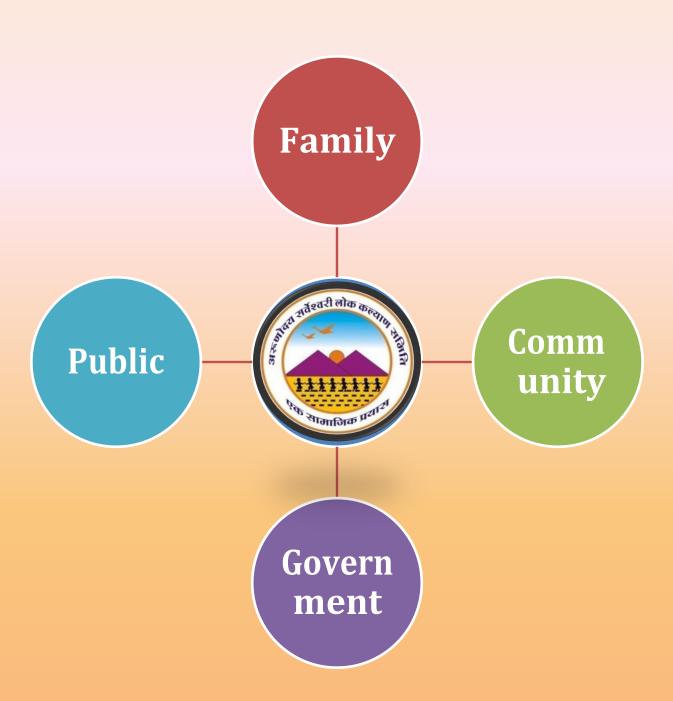

Our Approach



Common Facility Centre (CFC) for SHG members

This will lead to creation of tangible "assets" as Common Facility Centers (CFCs) like Common Production/Processing Centre (for balancing/correcting/improving production line that cannot be undertaken by individual units), Design Centers, Testing Facilities, Training Centre, R&D Centers, Effluent Treatment Plant, Marketing Display/Selling Centre, Common Logistics Centre, Common Raw Material Bank/Sales Depot, etc. The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Government of India (GoI) has adopted the cluster development approach as a key strategy for enhancing the productivity and competitiveness as well as capacity building of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) and their collectives in the country. A cluster is a group of enterprises located within an identifiable and as far as practicable, contiguous area and producing same/similar products/services. The essential characteristics of enterprises in a cluster are (a) Similarity or complementarily in the methods of production, quality control and testing, energy consumption, pollution control, etc (b) Similar level of technology and marketing strategies/practices (c) Channels for communication among the members of the cluster (d) Common challenges and opportunities.

Objects -

- To support he sustainability and growth of MSEs by addressing common issues such as improvement of technology, skills and quality, market access, access to capital, etc
- ➤ To build capacity of MSEs for common supportive action through formation of self help groups, consortia, up gradation of associations, etc.
- To create/upgrade infrastructural facilities in the new/existing industrial areas/ clusters of MSEs.
- To set up common facility centers (for testing, training centre, raw material depot, effluent treatment, complementing production processes, etc).



Farmer Producer Organsaztion



Arunodaya Sarveshwari Lok kalyan Samiti has 5 Farmer producer Organization is formed in this Year

A Producer Organisation (PO) is a legal entity formed by primary producers, viz. farmers, milk producers, fishermen, weavers, rural artisans, craftsmen. A PO can be a producer company, a cooperative society or any other legal form which provides for sharing of profits/benefits among the members. In some forms like producer companies, institutions of primary producers can also become member of PO. It is one type of PO where the members are farmers. Small Farmers' Agribusiness Consortium (SFAC) is providing support for promotion of FPOs. PO is a generic name for an organization of producers of any produce, e.g., agricultural, non-farm products, artisan products, etc.

- A . It is formed by a group of producers for either farm or non-farm activities.
- B. It is a registered body and a legal entity.
- C. Producers are shareholders in the organization.
- D. It deals with business activities related to the primary produce/product.
- E. It works for the benefit of the member producers.
- F. A part of the profit is shared amongst the producers.
- G. Rest of the surplus is added to its owned funds for business expansion.

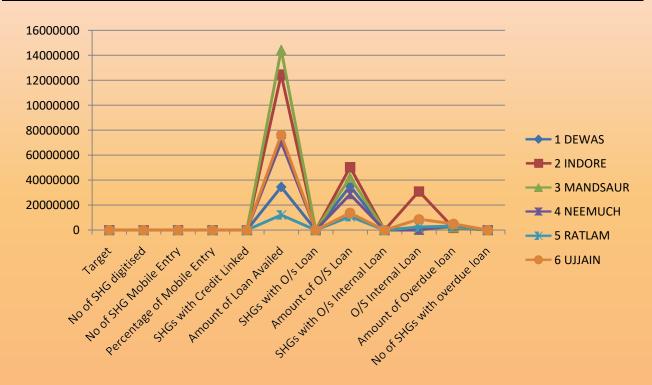

In addition, the would also mission address livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces, Institutional credit, social security and skills to the urban street vendors for accessing emerging market opportunities.

JLG is a cluster of group loan of 5 individual borrowers taking mutual guarantee of each other. The group is formed by their choice. The pre-condition to form JLG is that the cash flow in the business of the group should be similar in nature. All the members of the group are entrusted with the responsibility of one another for the given loan accountable for repayment of loan. Only females are encouraged to form JLGs. Loans are given to individual borrowers and loan amounts may vary to different members in a group. The groups are given the option for selecting the loan tenure according to the nature of the products and convenience of the members in the group. The tenure of the loan has to be uniform within a group.



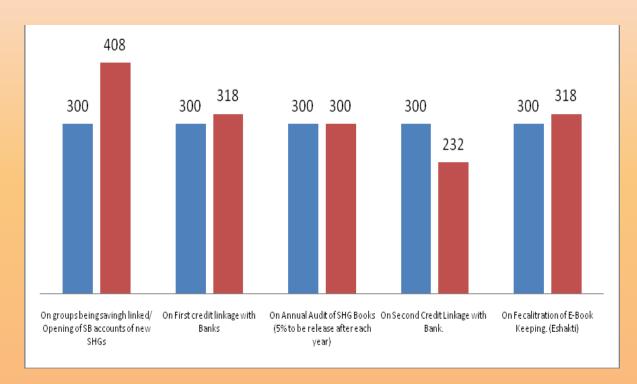

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan







Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (SBA), or Clean India Mission is a country-wide campaign initiated by the Government of india in 2014 to eliminate open defecation and improve Solid waste management (SWM). Phase 1 of the mission lasted till October 2021. Phase 2 will be implemented between 2021-22 and 2024-25. Initiated by the Government of India, the mission aimed to achieve an "open-defecation free" (ODF) India by 2 October 2021, the 151th anniversary of the birth of Mahatma Ganthi.

Livelihood and Enterprises Development Program (LEDP)

Micro Enterprises Development Program (MEDP)

As skill upgradation trainings alone have limited impact on livelihood creation among the SHG members, it was thought prudent to create sustainable livelihoods among SHG members and to attain optimum benefit out of skill up gradation and a new scheme titled Livelihood and Enterprise Development Programme (LEDP). It envisages conduct of livelihood promotion programmes in clusters. There is provision for intensive training for skill building, refresher training, backward-forward linkages and handholding & escort supports. It also encompasses the complete value chain and offers end-to-end solution to the SHG members. It is to be implemented on a project basis covering 15 to 30 SHGs in a cluster of contiguous villages where from SHG members may be selected.







Target Intervention Project (TI) Association with MPSACS:

National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) has been continuously evolving and strengthening its strategies across the HIV prevention, care, support and treatment continuum. HIV prevention strategies have been always been vigorously implemented, due to the dynamic nature of both the population at risk and the HIV epidemic. NACO through its mid-term assessment, understood the need for strengthening these strategies; hence there have been continuous discussions with the community, NGOs/CBOs and its partners on how to strengthen this model. Through its continuous interactions with a plethora of stakeholders, the leadership of NACO released the strategy document, "Targeted Intervention (TI) Revamped Strategies" in July 2019. To move forward in implementing the Revamped Strategies, NACO conducted a series of trainings from the national level to the state level. As part of this planning, a two-day Training of Trainers (ToT), was planned in two batches, with each batch having approximately 40 participants, from State AIDS Control Societies (SACS) and Technical Support Units (TSU). It is expected that these SACS and TSU officials will be conducting the next level training for the Project officers in TSUs, who will train and mentor the implementing partners, NGOs/CBOs.

MOBIEL VETERINARY VAN

With the financial support of the Department of Animal Medicine in the development block of Nalachha and Dhar district of Dhar district of Madhya Pradesh, the social service organization Arunodaya Sarveshwari Public Welfare Committee, is successfully implementing the unit of the ongoing medical treatment project from the year 2015, under which On the occasion of organizing the Hatbazar Mela Pashumela, and other cultural programs to be organized in the villages of these tribal development blocks, the work of distributing medicines at the village level is being successfully done by treating the sick animals through the veterinary medical unit,

Along with making the program effective, one day pre-natal medical unit is going to reach the selected villages, in which the work of informing people through village munadi, pemplate distribution is also being done. So that they can get their sick animals treated. Successful work under this project is currently being carried out by the organization with the goal.







Conducting Projects of Women and Child Development Department

Social labor organization Arunodaya Sarveshwari Public Welfare Committee, recognized by the Department of Women and Child Development, Karbal Labor Abolition Campaign, Beti Bachao Abhiyan, Malnutrition and Women Empowerment should be successfully conducted in 15 districts of Madhya Pradesh and 02 districts of Rajasthan. It has also been working continuously since the year 2014 to get the right of education to their children by advocating against the exploitation of women sex workers through HIV / AIDS awareness campaign. **Participating** vaccination, Godabharai scheme, Annaprashan Yojana, Anganwadi and Arogyakendra by the organization is also providing advice to Aasha workers and Anganwadi workers. Due to which Madhya Pradesh became the best state in preventing maternal mortality and infant mortality, it is engaged in its campaign.



Water Resource Management



Water Resource Management We believe that water has a direct connect with poverty and well being of rural communities. That's why our growing work in water stressed rural areas is focused on improving their access to water for agriculture and livestock. We are targeting localized solutions by improving, repairing already present water bodies like ponds, lakes, check dams etc. We mobilize and motivate rural communities and empower them to their own sustainable solutions. Cleaning water bodies, directing their ow, constructing new water access points and increasing water tables through rain water harvesting activities are some ideas that have emerged locally



WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROJECT

Rainfed areas assume special significance in terms of agricultural productivity and livelihood for millions of rural households in India. These areas not only constitute nearly 57 per cent of the cultivated area but also account for production of bulk of millets, pulses and oilseeds. Rainfed agriculture although is a risk-prone activity, have the potential to contribute a larger share in the food grain production, if managed properly. These high potential rainfed areas provide us with opportunities for faster agricultural growth compared to irrigated areas that have reached a plateau. In the context of climate change, watershed management plays an important role in mitigating weather induced risks, building resilience and strengthening adaptive capacities. In times of drought, it captures rainfall in-situ, recharging ground water sources.
